We are so grateful for all the donations we have received during this month. We were able to help 545 families consisting of 1127 people using food parcels alone. With the other larger food donations we received we were able to provide a further 1000 people with food. We would like to thank everyone who contributed towards this and in particular to Charities Aid Foundation. You have empowered us to reach out to these people in need.

We have also begun making masks now that wearing them has become compulsory. Pikkie, who runs our needlework classes took the initiative and in a flash there were 7 ladies making masks. We were able to distribute these to our food parcel beneficiaries. We are also offering them for sale @ R20 per mask. R10 of this goes to the lady who made the mask to help support her family in this difficult time. Many thanks to those people who have supported us in this venture and simultaneously helped families earn an income in these difficult times.
